SUMMARY OF PROPOSED BYLAW CHANGES

The OCPA Executive Council is recommending the following changes to the OCPA By-Laws:

- Clarify that OCPA membership can occur at anytime and not restrict when membership renewal occurs.
- Change the number of elected officers from eleven to nine to reflect the current operating structure of the Executive Council (replacing Vice President with an appointed Faculty Liaison and having just one Two-Year Member at Large).
- Note that the main vehicle of communication for elections and otherwise will occur electronically (not via U.S. mail).
- More specifically describe appointed positions and where they fit in the team structure of the OCPA Executive Council.
